school be added to the list.
 Harrison said she would bring the report back for more discussion at the next several meetings and discuss how the district will pay for it at the August meeting.
 "We want to really work on this and make sure it's what we need before we fund it," she said.
 Harrison connected to the meeting on her computer. Harrison said she had strep throat and used the Skype communication program to have a two-way conversation with the board from her office next door.
 "We're showing you how we can use

technology and how we do use technology in this district," she said.
 Curriculum Director Diana Wieland said the administrators use Skype to connect to state conferences and meetings, rather than use the gas to drive there.
 • The board voted to raise lunch prices for the next school year. Lunch will be \$2.10 for kindergarteners, first and second graders; \$2.30 for third through 12th graders; and remain at \$3.55 for adults.
 Harrison said the staff had reviewed lunch prices and found them to be low compared to surrounding districts, some of which charge more than \$2.50. The idea, she said, is to eventually have the food department

pay for itself.
 • The board gave the Colby Middle School cheerleaders permission to sell some old equipment and uniforms that aren't being used.
 • The board approved the resignations of teaching assistant Beckly Schiferl, secretary Mary Schlick and grade school teacher Gerri Balthazor, and hired Dana Inlow for food services.
 • Grade school Principal Lance Kranawitter said 15 students got ribbons in the Northwest Kansas Art Show. Brittany Alexander won best in show.
 • High school Principal Don Krebs said he has been interviewing candidates for a

half-time Spanish teacher. Krebs said the school might look at splitting a full-time teacher with Colby Community College or having a teacher connect virtually from elsewhere in Kansas.
 • Krebs said his staff is finishing their instructional budgets – or how much each money teacher requests for their classroom. Krebs expressed his admiration for how much the teachers have been willing to cut. The instructional budget was \$169,000 at the beginning of the 2009 school year. The teachers cut \$96,000 out during the year and are aiming for a total budget of less than \$70,000 for next year.

Saturday parade will kick off ox roast

The every-five-years Herndon Ox Roast kicks off Saturday morning with a parade down Main Street.
 At noon, the traditional barbecue will feature the same recipe used at each roast for nearly a century. That takes three cows and basketloads of carrots, apples, green peppers, tomatoes, onions and spices, said Nadine Green of Herndon, an Ox Roast volunteer. The meat and vegetables are cooked in a huge pan on a bed of hot coals, made with about 15 tons of wood.
 The vegetables, she said, are put into the pan first, then the meat and spices, along with 20 gallons of water. The lid put on the pan and lowered into the pit on the bed of hot coals. It's covered with about three feet of dirt and left to cook for 24 hours.
 After a day, the dirt is removed and a front-end loader is used to lift the pan out. After everything is removed, the gravy is made right in the pan.
 "The entire community gets involved," said Ms. Green. "Prairie Land Electric Co-op donates the beef, Ben-Lee Processing donates

the processing, Williams Brothers Grocery donates other necessities for the meal, Finley Construction donates and serves the iced tea, along with many other area businesses who give money or share their time and energy to make the day a success."
 The all-day celebration was first held in 1914 and drew 2,500 people. The theme for this year's roast is "What happens in Herndon, stays in Herndon."
 The schedule for the day:
 • 10 a.m. – parade on Main Street.
 • noon – lunch.
 • afternoon – music by Willis Pracht and Dianne Vap in the park.
 • 1 p.m. – mud volleyball on Keystone Street.
 • 2 p.m. – kid's games on the south football field.
 • 3:30 p.m. – cow-patty bingo on the north football field.
 • 5 p.m. – outhouse races on Main Street.
 • 7:30 p.m. – mass at St. Mary's Catholic Church.
 • 9 p.m. – street dance on Main Street.
 • 11 p.m. – fireworks.

Wave of violence grips capitol city

TOPEKA (AP) – Five days. Two slayings. More than 12 shootings.
 A wave of violence has enveloped the capital city.
 The Shawnee County district attorney is asking for the public's assistance in finding the perpetrators.
 Topeka police insist there is no cause for a general alarm. The shootings, police have said, weren't random and public safety isn't threatened.
 But residents in the affected areas say the shootings have left them skittish. There is even talk of moving away. One resident, however, said she isn't going anywhere.
 "I've lived here about 50 years," Josefina Guerrero, 71, said Wednesday as she sat on a shaded swing beneath an apple tree in her fenced-in front

yard next door to the home where Ronald Eugene Grier, 41, was fatally shot about 9:30 a.m. Tuesday. "Nobody's bothered me. I'm not concerned. "I leave people alone. They leave me alone."
 Several neighborhood children, some of whom said they were outside at the time of Tuesday's shooting, joined Guerrero in the shade.
 On Wednesday, District Attorney Chad Taylor said a charge of first-degree murder had been filed against Stephen A. Macomber, 43, in connection with Monday afternoon's fatal shooting of Ryan Lofton, 26, who died after being wounded in the driveway of a home.
 On Tuesday morning, the city recorded its sixth homicide of 2010 – and second in a 24-hour period – when Grier was shot and killed at his house. No arrests have been reported.
