## Habitat a conservation option

Farmers and ranchers with land \$750,000 ... for assistance to land coming out of the Conservation Reserved Program may be able to get federal money from a national initiative to help improve habitat for the lesser prairie chicken.

Applications will be accepted through June 25 by the U.S. Natural Resources Conservation Service, said Andy Burr, soil conservationist at the Colby office, "The current contracts are ex-

piring for land that has been in the Conservation Reserve Program," said Burr, "and the question is that now that it's expired, what do we do with it? "If land owners would consider

grazing, there's expense for fences and developing watering systems, but with grazing, it doesn't destroy prairie chicken habitat."

"Kansas has been alloted

owners in transitioning ... to managed grazing lands," said Eric B. Banks, state conservationist for the service, "by helping with the cost of fences and water systems, and to help develop an improved lesser prairie chicken habitat on their land."

Banks said the idea is to target technical and financial assistance on expired Conservation Reserve fields that are to be maintained in permanent cover and use them for grazing. The program is available in 34 western Kansas counties with low populations of lesser prairie chickens.
