# New scholarships offered by community foundation

The Thomas County Community Foundation has announced two new scholarship funds available for Thomas County students and those attending Colby Community College.

The Chuck Dempewolf Community Service Scholarship was created by Kansas Quick Lube in honor of a Colby resident. Dempewolf volunteered with the American Cancer Society, Big Brothers Big Sisters, Special Olympics, the school's booster club and his church. He grew up in Colby, attended Colby High School and the college, and worked here until his death in 2005.

Jaylea Black, daughter of Jay and Cindy Black of Colby, is the first to receive the \$500 scholarship, said Melinda Olson, executive director of the foundation.

Black was selected primarily on the basis of community service, though she also had to have at least a 2.5 grade average. She has an extensive service record as the coordinator of Prairieland Food, a volunteer for the Genesis-Thomas County Food Bank, Baskets for the Elderly, the United Methodist Church

and Santa's Workshop. Black plans to attend the college and transfer to Oklahoma State University to study premed or biology.

The Terry Strutt Memorial Scholarship, a \$2,000, two-year renewable opportunity, was established by the Darwin and Tammi Strutt family to help graduating seniors of Logan and Thomas counties attend Colby Community College.

The first recipient is Adam Weber, son of Omar and Shirley Weber of Colby, Olson said.

Weber was chosen based on his involvement in extracurricular activities as well as his grades. He has participated in Colby High School football, wrestling and track. He placed fifth at the state wrestling championships and was twice named all-league in football.

"We are so thankful for Patrick and Sally Toth, owners of Kansas Quick Lube, and the Darwin and Tammi Strutt family for establishing these financial opportunities for our young adults," said Olson. "These scholarships wouldn't be available if it weren't for our generous donors."

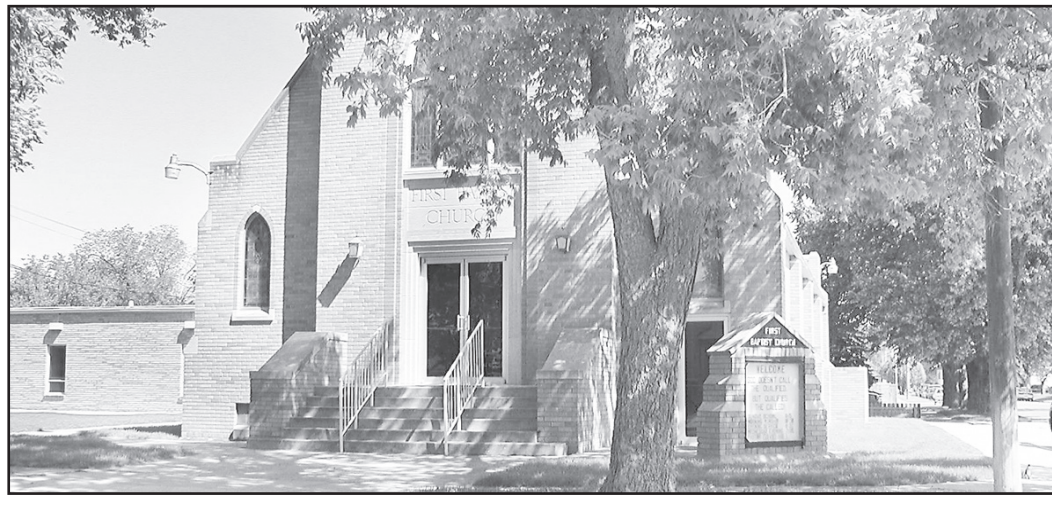
