# Parents alerted to product recall

A food safety bulletin from Kansas State University urges parents to check cupboard shelves for cans with three varieties of SpaghettiOs With Meatballs. Karen Blakeslee, Kansas State University Extension food specialist, said the products are part of a 15-million-pound food recall which may contain underprocessed meat. The products, made at Campbell's Soup Supply Co. in Paris, Texas, should be returned to the store for a refund, Blakeslee said. Recalled products include 14.75-ounce cans of SpaghettiOs With Meatballs, bearing the code "U5" on the bottom, SpaghettiOs A to Z with Meatballs with the code "4N" on the bottom and SpaghettiOs Fun Shapes with Meatballs (cars) with the code "KS" on the bottom. All cans will be marked with "EST 4-K" with a "use by" date between June and December 2011 on the bottom. The products were distributed nationally, Blakeslee said, and while no illness has been reported to date, the cans should be returned rather than eaten. "Don't worry about having a receipt," said Blakeslee, noting that food companies which suspect a problem appreciate the returns. For questions, call the Campbells hotline at (866) 495-3774.

# Rat starts fire

YAKIMA, Wash. (AP) – A rat is suspected of starting a fire at the Veterans of Foreign War building in Yakima. KAPP-TV reports that investigators discovered a rat had chewed through an electrical cord. The rat apparently caught fire and ran to its nest, igniting flammable items. The fire last week spread quickly through the building, damaging several rooms and war memorabilia. Damage could exceed \$1 million.


