The Colby Free Press' Cointest will return July 4. It will be held during the High Plains Lions Club festivities at the Thomas County Fairgrounds 4-H building at 7 pm.

People interested in playing will guess what side a coin will land on. Those who think the coin will land heads, will stand on one side of the room. Those who think the coin will land tails, will stand on the opposite side of the room. Whatever side the coin lands, the people who guessed that side will continue to play. Those who guessed the other side are out of the game.

By the process of elimination, the last person still playing, will win \$234. The \$234 amount is patriotic - it's the same number of years the United States has been in existence. The prize will be in the \$1 presidential coins.

Participants do not have to pick the same side of the coin for every round. People can change their mind as the game progresses.

Depending upon size of the participants, the coin toss may be moved outside of the 4-H building. "We hope for a good turn out this year," said Free Press Publisher, Steve Haynes.

Haynes is grateful of the High Plains Lions Club and their efforts for the Fourth of July. "Due to popular demand we are
