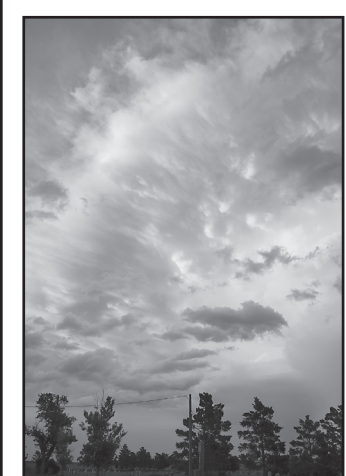


Weather Corner

direction signs were "wonderful," adding that whoever thought of them probably should get a medal.

"We're permanent RV'ers," said Sally, "so permanent, in fact, that our driver's licenses have 'continuous traveler' printed right on the front."

Sally said the couple sold their home five years ago and been traveling since.

She said that for voting purposes, they have to have an address, so they have a "little square corner" in Bend, but for the most part, they're on the road. They also use the property in Oregon to get their mail.

Sally, a California native, said she's done many things that she has enjoyed, from floral design, to cocktail waitress, to owning a shop called Hibernation where she

sold dolls and bears, to delivering newspapers in Carmel, Calif., when actor Clint Eastwood was mayor. She said she went back to college and got a degree, and then married a man from Topeka.

"He's retired military," she said, "and then he worked for Trane (a heating and air-conditioning supplier) for several years, and when he decided we should sell our home and travel, of course I was willing to try it, too."

Two paving projects planned for highways

Stewart said the contractor will use the road material milled up from U.S. 24 in the new asphalt on all three parts of the project.

"We will reuse the old roadway," he said.

Twenty-five percent of the resurfacing material will come from U.S. 24, he said.

Brands said the whole project will cost about \$2.7 million and is expected to be completed by mid-October.

The transportation department has also bid several new projects, including a seal on U.S. 83 from Oakley to the Nine-Mile corner, to Heft and Sons from Greensburg for \$508,474.

State education board wants budget increase

TOPEKA (AP) - Members of the state Board of Education are seeking an increase of \$471 million next year from the Legislature for Kansas public schools.

The *Lawrence Journal-World* reports the board made its recommendation Tuesday on a 7-1-1 vote. Supporters say the request encourages legislators to "fund the law" governing public school funding.

Board members made the request as part of their annual plea to the governor as the 2011-12 budget is prepared. The amount would be a 15 percent increase over current levels.

However, some board members argued that seeking such an increase would require a tax increase at a time when other areas of state government and the private sector are cutting budgets and staff.
