College to start solar classes

skills taught in the energy classes meet the guidelines of nationally recognized curriculum.

In other business, the board:

- Heard Alan Waites, vice president of business affairs, say the college had \$1,270,000 left over from its 2009-2010 budget. He said the school brought in \$1,515,000 in June and spent \$831,000.
- Heard Moorhous report on a solar photovoltaic training seminar he went to in Stuttgart, Ark., in mid-June. The seminar was put on by Ontility, a renewable energy training company. Later, Moorhous said the college sent him to the seminar so he would be ready to teach students about solar photovoltaic energy, or electricity generated by solar cells, this fall.

He said he learned what companies were in the business and where they are. Moorhous said he also found out how much it costs to buy and install solar cells. Solar gear can be rented, he added. On the last day of the seminar, they

learned how to install a solar array, a number of solar panels put together; on a simulated rooftop, said Moorhous.

- Agreed to approve having Chairman Cindy Black's name replace board member Arlen Leiker's on the accounts at Sunflower Bank (General Fund and Money Market Accounts), Farmers and Merchants Bank (Bond Fund) and The Bank (Student Union/Dorm). Leiker made the motion.
- Approved the re-election of Black as board chairman and ex-officio member to the Endowment Foundation board, Kent Krehbiel, vice chairman; Mark Winger, treasurer; Dr. Lynn Kreider, president of the college, secretary of the board; and Leiker, Kansas Association of Community College Trustees representative.
- OK'd a lease agreement with the Norton County Hospital for \$766 a month. Students in the college nursing program take classes at the hospital.
- Approved athletic insurance from QBE Speciality Insurance

at a premium of \$91,000 a year. Kreider noted that this was a \$4,000 decrease from last year. Leiker asked how the money is divided between each sport. Waites said its allocated based on the number of athletes.

- Agreed to pay Mutual of Omaha \$8,363 for catastrophic health insurance for athletes in wrestling and rodeo. Rodeo and wrestling are the only two sports that have catastrophic insurance, said Ryan Sturdy, athletic director at the college.
- OK'd a sale of livestock by Dr. Marcy Ward, beef cattle director at the college. That will reduce her herd by 20-25 head, Kreider said.
- Approved charging 75 cents per copy for records requested by the public.
- Decided to approve Kreibel's motion to terminate the part-time contracts of international recruiter Lindsay Bennett and residential hall coordinator Matt Dickson. Dickson will remain as assistant coach of the baseball team.

BP chief bounced 100 days into spill

NEW ORLEANS – One hundred days after the rig explosion that set off the worst offshore oil spill in U.S. history, the oil giant behind it is hoping to move beyond the losses, the gaffes and the live video that ran for weeks of the busted well coughing up massive amounts of crude every second.

BP is replacing Chief Executive Officer Tony Hayward with Managing Director Robert Dudley, setting aside \$30 billion in assets and selling \$32.2 billion to cover the long-term cost of the spill. It's

also claiming a \$9.88 billion tax credit in the second quarter based on the \$32.2 billion charge.

Hayward, who has been repeatedly criticized for other verbal miscues, will step down Oct. 1 with benefits valued at more than \$18 million. BP is recommending him for a nonexecutive board position at its Russian joint venture, TNK-BP.

Dudley pledged that his company will remain committed to the Gulf region even after the busted well is sealed for good – something that may happen soon. A temporary cap has held back the oil for nearly two weeks, a "static

kill" effort to plug the well from above is to begin Monday and a relief well could begin sealing the well from the bottom for good.

"We can't find out exactly what caused it and where the failure happened, however it did not affect Internet service. Sometimes an equipment failure happens, and is fixed, and we don't get any information at all."

Amy Applebury, a customer service representative at the Colby S&T office, said anyone who tried to use the phone around 11 a.m. got a message saying all circuits were busy. She said the large number of calls being made caused an overflow on the circuit, which triggered the message.

State asks for money to help with storm repair

TOPEKA (AP) – Kansas federal funds to help pay for removing debris and repairing infrastructure following storms and flooding in June.

Lt. Gov. Troy Findley has sent a request for a disaster declaration to the federal government. He acted for Gov. Mark Parkinson during Parkinson's recent trip to England

for an international air show.

Findley says the federal assistance will help the 77 counties affected by the storms to clean up and make repairs to roads, bridges and utilities.

The state estimates that the counties face nearly \$11 million worth of cleanup and repairs, most of it in fixing roads and bridges.
