Goodland college wins respiratory accreditation

The Commission on Accreditation for Respiratory Care voted on July 17 to award initial accreditation to the Associate of Applied Science Degree in respiratory therapy at Northwest Kansas Technical College.

A review conducted by the group confirmed the program's compliance with the nationally established accreditation standards, said Dr. Ed Mills, Northwest Tech president.

"Leona Evans and Scott Hubbell, faculty for the program, have made a commitment to continuous quality improvement in respiratory therapy education, and building a top-notch program," Mills said. "The respiratory therapy program at Northwest Tech continues to grow, with enrollment numbers increasing to 16 new students this year."

In the words of a former student,

"I had a bachelor's degree in biology, but wasn't sure what I wanted to do and decided to apply for the RT program at Northwest Tech. It was a good decision, because I now have a great job."

"The program taught me the skills and what I needed to know to be successful as a respiratory therapist."

The college continues to explore the possibility of offering other allied health career programs, Mills said. It already offers a medical assistant program at the Goodland campus and now has a program at the North Central Technical College Campus in Hays. Northwest Tech will also be offering a Certified Nurse Aide program beginning Sept. 8.
