### NOTICE OF PLACES AND DATES OF ORDER FOR CLOSING OF REGISTRATION BOOKS BEFORE THE GENERAL ELECTION NOVEMBER 2, 2010

Pursuant to the provisions of K.S.A. 25-2311 (c), notice is hereby given that on the 18TH day of October, 2010; all registration books for the primary election will close at the end of regular business hours. Registration books will remain closed until the 3rd day of November, 2010.

A citizen of the United States who is eighteen (18) years of age and upwards, or will have attained the age of (18) years of age at the next election, must register before he or she can vote. Voter registration books close fourteen (14) days before an election.

When a voter has been registered according to law, his or her registration shall continue to be valid until one of the following occurs:

1. The voter changes his or her name by marriage/divorce, etc.
2. The voter changes residence (moves) into county or within county.
3. The voter's name has been purged according to law (not voted in two (2) National/State elections).

If any of the above has occurred, you must re-register.

An individual applicant may request an application for registration in person, by telephone or in writing, by such applicant, to the County Election Officer.
