Rock jam session closes Los Angeles freeway

LOS ANGELES (AP) — A rock band will have to face the music after blocking a Los Angeles freeway to perform atop its trailer.

California Highway Patrol spokesman Rick Quintero says a big box van decorated with the Imperial Stars' logo stopped on the southbound U.S. 101 near Sunset Boulevard about 10:30 a.m. Tuesday, blocking four of the five lanes. The driver took the keys and fled in another car, then three musicians

climbed on top of the van and began to perform.

Quintero says they were arrested and the truck was finally towed away around noon after causing a mile-long traffic jam. He says the musicians could face charges of obstructing traffic.

The group, whose credits include the song "Traffic Jam 101," says on its website it is dedicated to helping homeless children.
