Once the governor makes the request to the agriculture department, the local Farm Service Agency offices assemble information on how much was lost, which is submitted to the State Emergency Board. The agency's state emergency director, Adrian Polansky, also prepares a recommendation.

The agency's Disaster Assistance Branch, Emergencies Section, reviews all the information and then makes a recommendation to the agriculture secre-

According to the agency, 95 Kansas counties have already been put under disaster declarations this year. Some of the declarations have expired.


