

Veterans' Day Parade



Thursday, Nov. 11, 2010
4 p.m. Downtown Colby

Area veterans will march down Franklin Avenue at 4 p.m. Thursday as part of Colby's program honoring veterans who have served their country in the military in times of war and peace.

Dale Deaver of Colby, an Army Air Corps veteran of World War II, said it will take 30 to 40 vets to help carry the big flag down the parade route from North Franklin to Second Street, where they will turn east and march to the Thomas County Courthouse and the Veterans Memorial.

The Colby High School band will take

its place in the parade and participate in the Veterans Day ceremonies at the courthouse. Jim Vap, a retired National Guardsman who owns Vap Distributing, will speak, and Deaver will lead the crowd in singing "God Bless America."

Parade participants are asked to gather at the north end of Franklin by Fike Park for line up.

Following the ceremonies at the courthouse, everyone is invited to go to the American Legion about 4:30 p.m. for food and visiting.
