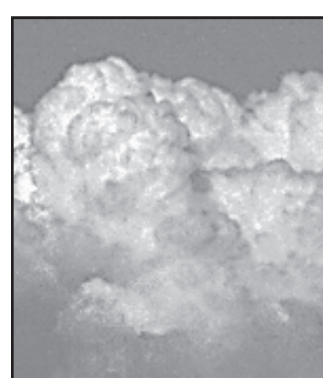


Weather Corner

sent information that the tax sale that had been set for Dec. 17 will have to be postponed until after the first of the year because the *Colby Free Press* neglected to publish the second notice of sale. The law requires three consecutive weeks of publication for a county tax

sale, he said. "We have to wait for a court date from the judge," Flipse said on Tuesday. "He has been out of town, and was out of his office today, so it looks like it will be Wednesday before we can even look for a date."

Later in the week, the county attorney said the sale had been set

for 10 a.m. Friday, Jan. 14. "People with property in the sale will not have to be notified by certified mail again," he said, "because public notice is all that's required at this point. We'll just have to start over with another date."

In other business, the commissioners:

- Approved a \$1,300 invoice from Computer Information Concepts for a program called Peopleware. The commissioners tabled the payment at last week's meeting so they could verify it is in the original contract.

- Asked the road department to fix a wind-damaged louver by the clock tower on the courthouse.
- Approved meeting dates for the coming month of Monday, Dec. 6, 13 and 20, and Friday, Dec. 31.

Citizen recalls war years activities

A staff began to wonder how they could help with the war effort.

Thus, the "Gals About Town" were created. They decided their best efforts would be to help promote communications and thus support the soldiers and their friends and families at home in Colby. They began a newsletter for the troops and collected information, insights, stories and even humor from all over town.

Their work supplies included a mimeograph machine, a paper cutter and a pot of glue. After gathering "news," they cut the stencils with their manual typewriters, and then cut and pasted until they had a "news book" to send to our soldiers.

Of course, this was done only in the evenings after work. One

special benefit was an agreement from the Manhattan state headquarters that they could use the office equipment for this project and even use postage to send the news books.

Scrapbooks were made to include a review of this project, and they kept letters from soldiers telling about how much they enjoyed the information and that they shared with soldier friends from all parts of the country. One such scrapbook and an interview made by Larry Barrett interviewing Lee are both housed by the Thomas County Historical Society at the Prairie Museum.

Lee notes that the "Gals About Town" didn't really get to help soldiers personally, except for one time she recalls the Rock Island station agent let Leta Secret know that a troop train would be

stopping in Colby and he could let the Gals provide treats on one train car. Donations were solicited and the O'Pelt Hotel shared a carton of cigarettes which were bundled into packages of two and wrapped in waxed paper. Mrs. Prof Phillips gave popcorn from the Lyric Theatre and the "Gals About Town" pooled their sugar rations and made some homemade candy.

Before going to the train, Irma located her high school drum major white boots, wore a red pants suit and borrowed a white fur coat from Julia Schroeder. The "Gals About Town" were a hit and they had delightful conversations with the troops, shared their goodies and reminded the soldiers to share with those in the other train cars.
