Kansas State University is teaming up with the University of Missouri, University of Nebraska, and Iowa State University to present the 4-State Beef Conference in January at locations in each state.
"The 4-State Beef Conferences are designed to give beef cattle interests in Iowa, Kansas, Missouri, and Nebraska a regular update on current cow-calf and stocker topics," said Joel DeRouchey, livestock specialist with K-State Research and Extension.
"Topics planned are: multi-year selection impact, Dave Patterson, Missouri; benefitting from feeding on pasture, Dale Blasi, K-State; threats to the industry, Daren Wil-

liams, National Cattlemen's Beef Association; and low-input heifer development - Rick Funston, Nebraska.

The Kansas session will begin at 9:30 a.m. Wednesday, Jan. 12, at the Jackson County Fair Building, Fifth and Dakota St. in Holton.
