aren't enforced enough. The senator-elect agreed that antitrust enforcement was lacking. "If you're too big to fail," Moran said, "you shouldn't be in business. Anti-trust matters. "We don't enforce our antitrust laws in a sufficient way to promote competition." "Animal rights" groups are emerging as a threat to the livestock industry, Moran said, replacing environmental groups as a problem for stockmen. Moran joked about raising money for the local Humane Society in Hays, then getting "hate mail" asking why he supported an extreme animal rights group. "That was the local dog shelter, not the national group," he said. A woman asked Moran where he thought the health-care situation was heading. Moran said he continues to oppose many of the provisions in the health-care laws, but it is unlikely the whole thing will be repealed. "Any bill that repeals Health Care Reform is not going to be signed by President Obama," he said. Moran said the new laws, especially the provision which requires businesses to file Internal Revenue Service 1099 forms for all vendors, are just adding billions in expense and wasted time. "How many people at the hospital work at filling out government forms?" Moran asked Hospital Administrator Steve Granzow. "Most of them," Granzow replied. Moran said he would like to make sure people with

pre-existing conditions are covered and that cost and risk in insurance are spread out. "If we were going to start over, I don't think we'd ever tie insurance to employment," he added. "I don't know how you'd (change) it today, but there are some things we can do." Moran said he is fearful that the new laws are driving costs up, not down. Those increasing costs, he said, could force cuts to programs like Medicare, which would hurt rural hospitals. Many rural hospitals, like Sheridan County's, depend on Medicare reimbursements, he noted. Moran said he wanted to protect rural critical access hospitals and make sure they are not eliminated. "I worry that just like it's been with schools in Topeka, it's going to be hospitals in Washington," he said. "I think they may look at hospitals and say, 'Why do you need a hospital in Hoxie when you have one in Colby - or Hays.'" Another man asked Moran if he would support bailouts for states in bad financial shape, similar to the bank bailouts for companies like insurance giant AIG. Moran said he opposed the AIG bailout and continued to oppose any bailouts. "I can't imagine a circumstance where I would vote to use taxpayer money to bail out the taxpayers of California," he said. Because Americans are allowed to choose what state they live in, he said, each state's residents should ultimately be responsible for their state government.

New antique shop keeps fires burning

"I hired a chemist out of Denver to teach me how to do everything I needed to do," he said. "That guy was here for two days, and then I was on my own. Man, I screwed up a lot of stuff at the start, and would have to do it all over again, or go somewhere to look for more parts, so it was sort of trial and error to begin with. "I didn't know stoves were such a big thing until John Nickel brought me a couple of stoves and asked me to nickel-plate them both. Nickel said he'd take one and I could have the other one for my work. That was over 500 stoves ago." Havel said it takes him about two months to sandblast, weld and nickel plate eight to 10 stoves. He has 17 on the show room floor now, with about 100 in storage, and they are all for sale. He noted he'd sold stoves all the way from California to Maine and Florida. One of the Blackhawk casinos in Colorado has a Havel-restored stove with spotlights on it to make it glisten.

"It's quite a conversation piece," he said. Stoves aren't all he has for sale. He has a plethora of antiques from nested Pyrex bowls to old brass gas nozzles to art prints, glass, furniture and lots and lots of interesting stuff. The store is named after his dog, a long-haired Shih Tzu which is constantly at his side or in his arms. Havel said he hasn't decided yet when to have regular open hours, but the store is always open by appointment. "My number, is (785) 443-

0900, and it's on the front door," he said.
