

College plans four-day youth horsemanship camp

A four-day Horsemanship Camp will be held by Colby Community College Sunday through Wednesday, June 5-8. The camp is designed to be an educational and fun experience for youth ages 12-17. Campers will be taught by Equestrian Team coach Shanda Mattix, assisted by members of the college equestrian team.

"English and Western disciplines will be available," said Mattix. "Additional activities are planned to expose campers to the CCC campus and help participants get to know one another."

Camp will begin at 3 p.m. Sunday with camper registration and horse check-in at the College Agricultural Center three miles east and one north of Colby. On the final day campers will demonstrate their skills for parents before leaving for home at 11 a.m.

All campers must have previous riding experience and be able to demonstrate basic riding skills.

Campers are encouraged to bring their own horses to the camp. A limited number of college-owned horses will be available at a cost of \$50. Campers who bring their

Camp will begin at 8:30 a.m. with camper registration and horse check-in at the college's agricultural center three miles

east and one mile north of Colby. The day camp will end at 4 p.m. Lunch will be provided.

The day will combine riding lessons, lectures and activities on topics such as breeds, nutrition and horse behavior.

Campers are encouraged to bring their own horses. A very limited number of college-owned horses will be available at an additional cost of \$10.

Cost is \$75. Registration is limited to 15 campers. Deadline for registration is May 1.
