House rejects tax repeal proposals

figures from the state Department of Labor.

Reducing the sales tax rate, which is scheduled to drop to 5.4 percent in 2013, would have cut more than \$390 million from projected state revenues in fiscal year 2012. That would have exacerbated a projected shortfall of \$493 million in the budget that legislators have yet to fill.

"Think about where we would be this year if we hadn't passed the tax increase," said Rep. Ed Trimmer, a Winfield Democrat. "I thought it was the right thing to do. To add more to the deficit is just plain irresponsible."

The second plan defeated in the House would have locked in the sales tax rate increase to pay for phasing out of corporate and individual income taxes. The plan called for reducing income tax rates by an equal percentage in any year that income tax collections exceed projections.

Rep. Tom Burroughs, a Kansas City Democrat, noted that many of the same "special interest groups" that campaigned against Democrats and moderate Republicans who supported the tax increase last session now were supporting keeping the rate in place.

He said voting to make the rate permanent was "not going to settle

Legislators raised the state sales tax last year to 6.3 percent in an effort to close a budget deficit. However, state revenue collections have barely kept pace with expectations since the increase took effect. As a result, Republican Gov. Sam Brownback on March 11 was forced to impose \$56.5 million in spending cuts to balance the current budget.

Brownback campaigned on reforming the Kansas tax code to improve the business climate and attract new workers. He has proposed a plan to give a five-year income tax abatement to residents moving from out of state to any Kansas county that has experienced double-digit population declines over the past decade.

The governor did not advocate for legislators to repeal the sales tax increase as part of his firstterm agenda.

House members did approve one Brownback plan that grants greater tax credits for the expensing of capital purchase by businesses. The measure also winds down several tax credit programs in a move to reform how the state encourages economic growth.

Final action on that bill was scheduled for today.


