Trojans nine takes five of six on road trip

The Colby Community College baseball team went five of six on the road last week, beating Hesston College twice last Wednesday and Cloud County Community College three times Saturday and Sunday in Concordia.

The Trojans won 5-1 in the first game Saturday and lost 5-3 in the second.

In the first game Sunday, the Thunderbirds put up two runs in the first inning on a single and a home run to left field. They added another run with a triple and a sacrifice fly ball in the second.


However, the Trojans burst into the game with an 11-run third. With one out, sophomore Matt Edwards reached first on an error and then stole second. Freshman Tyler Hays walked. Freshman Austin Russell singled to left, driving in Edwards and advancing Hays to second. He would reach home plate when sophomore Robert Glover hit a single to right.

With Russell and Glover at the corners, sophomore Jon Cotter got on base on an error by the shortstop, which also brought Russell home to tie the game at 3. Glover moved to second. Freshman Brandon Wilson belted a home to left, putting the Trojans up by 3 with just one out.

With the bases empty again, freshman Nick Bata singled to left and then stole second. A few minutes later, sophomore Kurtis Baker brought him home with a homer to center. The Trojans now led 8-3.

Back at the top of the batting order, sophomore Nathan Wilson, who flied out in the first at-bat of the inning, was hit by a pitch. He stole second and got to third on an error by the Thunderbirds' pitcher. and 4 errors. He would score when Edwards reached first on an error and kept going to second.

After a pitching change, Hayes singled to left, driving in Edwards. Hays was picked off at first for the second out, but the Trojans weren't done yet. Russell singled to right field and stole second.

The Trojans would score 11 runs again in the second game, but more gradually. Baker reached home on an error by the Thunderbirds' shortstop in the second. two runs in its half of the inning.

Colby took the lead again in the third. Baker was hit by a pitch with the bases loaded, forcing Russell home. Cotter scored on a sacrifice fly by Glover, making the score 3-2 Colby.

Cloud County tied the game at 3 in the bottom of the third with a double. Colby quickly took the lead again in the fourth with a sacrifice fly by freshman Zach Wilson that brought Hayes home. Russell scored on a single by freshman Brandon Wilson.

The game would remain at 5-3 Thunderbirds' center fielder. Cloud County took the lead with until the top of the sixth. After two pitching changes by Cloud County, Baker got two runs batted in on a double to right. The Thunderbirds made a third pitching change, but Glover hit a sacrifice fly to center field to drive in Baker. Colby added another run in the top of the seventh on a single by Rus-

Cloud County scored 4 more runs, 1 in the eighth and 3 in the ninth, but they couldn't overcome the Trojans' lead. The game ended at 11-9.

Colby's Drew Posegate picked up the win. In six innings, he gave up 5 runs on 7 hits. Cloud's Kevin Shaffer got the loss.
