## Team mom helps KU players get by

LAWRENCE (AP) – Whether they need a ride, a hug, or a home cooked meal, the Kansas players know Angel Morris is there for them.

"My mom had two sisters and one brother," she said. "One sister had seven kids. The brother had 14 kids and the other sister had 10. And we were always close.
