## Fines pay off for food bank

Tara Schroer, head librarian at the H. F. Davis Library at Colby Community College, has a solution for those who have overdue fines. "Food for Fines" eliminates overdue fees and contributes to Genesis Thomas County. The program lets students donate one food item for each dollar they owe in late or lost book fees. For example, donating 10 packages of ramen noodles results in subtraction of \$10 in overdue fees. "This is a win-win situation for our students, our faculty association and our local food bank," said Schroer. "It's a great way to clear up these charges while helping the community."
