Tech school adds hybrid repair

Northwest Kansas Technical College will be offering certification in hybrid collision repair training. An alliance agreement was signed by Northwest Tech and the Auto Career Development Center last month, which will allow Northwest Tech to collaborate with the center to deliver their Hybrid Automotive Training, and offer the nationally recognized certification in hybrid automotive repair.

"To the best of my knowledge," said Larry McLemore, "we are the only institution in the nation who offers a third party certification in hybrid collision repair specifically." McLemore, Northwest Tech collision repair instructor, and automotive instructor Curt Goodwin are two of a handful of instructors in
