Students' art places in Oberlin

The Seventh Annual High Plains ArtFest was April 15 to 17 at the Gateway Event Center in Oberlin. Artists, patrons and guests attended the opening on the evening of the 15th and voted to determine the People's Choice Award.

There were 341 pieces of art entered in the show, 258 in the adult category and 83 in the student art category from 13 high schools. Brenda Meder, executive director and curator of the Hays Arts Council, was the judge.

Several Colby students won awards, including Brittany Bange, senior, "Down the Road," acrylic, second place, people's choice; and "Dark Elegance," watercolor, Juror's Merit Award; Emilea Finley, junior, "On the Dock," oil, second place; Kayla Hockersmith, senior, "Kansas Beach," 2-D, mixed media, Juror's Merit Award; and Brenna McKee, "Four," charcoal drawing, Juror's Merit Award.

Next year there will be a category for cell phone photography. Saturday attendees at the show will be able to cast a ballot for a "People's Choice" cash award. There will be categories for children 12 and under and for everyone older than 12.
