

Music teacher recognized for excellence

Long-time Colby Community College instructor Pat Ziegelmeier was recognized for teaching excellence as part of commencement activities on May 14. Ziegelmeier was the recipient of the 2011 Tangeman Award given to recognize the year's outstanding teacher.

Ziegelmeier began teaching at the college in 1989 after completing a Bachelor of Arts degree at the University of Wyoming and a Master's in Educational Administration at Fort Hays State University. She teaches piano, keyboard skills, harmony and fundamentals of music. In addition, she is the accompanist for the college's concert choir and Sunflower Singers.
