

Colby comes out on top in Burlington

The Colby Swim Club dominated the Burlington swim meet June 25, grabbing first place with 301 team points. Goodland followed in second with 240 points, and Burlington came in third with 210 points. Wray finished in fourth place with 181 points, and Holyoke barely missed fourth and landed in fifth with 180 points. Oberlin was next with 155 points for sixth, Oakley came in seventh with 40 points and Flagler finished in last place with 18 points.
