## ORDINANCE NO. 179

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE POSITION OF CITY MARSHAL BE IT ORAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF REXFORD, KANSAS:**

Section 1. **CITY MARSHAL**, The law enforcement department shall consist of a city marshal and such number of regular law enforcement officers as shall be appointed as provided by Kansas law.

Section 2. **LAW ENFORCEMENT PERSONNEL; GENERAL DUTIES.** It shall be the general duty of the city marshal and all sworn law enforcement personnel to the best of their ability to preserve good order, peace and quiet throughout the city as provided by law or ordinance.

The city marshal and all sworn law enforcement personnel shall at all times have power to make arrest under proper process or without process on view of any offense against the laws of the State of Kansas or laws of the city and to keep all persons so arrested, unless admitted to bail, in the county jail or other proper place to prevent their escape until their trial can be had before the proper officer.

All persons arrested for violation of any law of the state and who shall not be charged with an offense under any law of the city shall be released to the custody of the sheriff of the county and such arrest shall be reported to the county attorney.

Section 3. **RULES AND REGULATIONS.** The city marshal shall have power to make such rules and regulations as may be necessary for the proper and efficient conduct to the department. Such rules and regulations shall be approved by the governing body.

Section 4. **REPEAL.** All ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed.

Section 5. **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official city newspaper.

# Farm Service deadlines soon

The Farm Service Agency in Kansas reminds producers of the following program deadlines.

• Friday – Final date to apply for 2009 Supplement Revenue Assistance Program.

• Next Monday – Final date for nominations for the County Committee election.

• Next Monday – Final date to request 2011 farm combination and/or farm division for a farm with base acres.

• Next Monday – Final date to report spring-seeded crops, conservation reserve and Noninsured Crop Disaster Assistance Program

acres. Prevented planting must be reported no later than 15 days after the final planting date. Failed acreage must be reported before disposition of the crop.

• Aug. 31 – Final date for conservation reserve program emergency haying.

• Sept. 1 – Final application date for 2012 Noninsured Crop Disaster Assistance Program coverage on small grain crops, except oats. Coverage is required to remain eligible for most disaster programs.

• Sept. 30 – Final date for conservation reserve emergency grazing.
