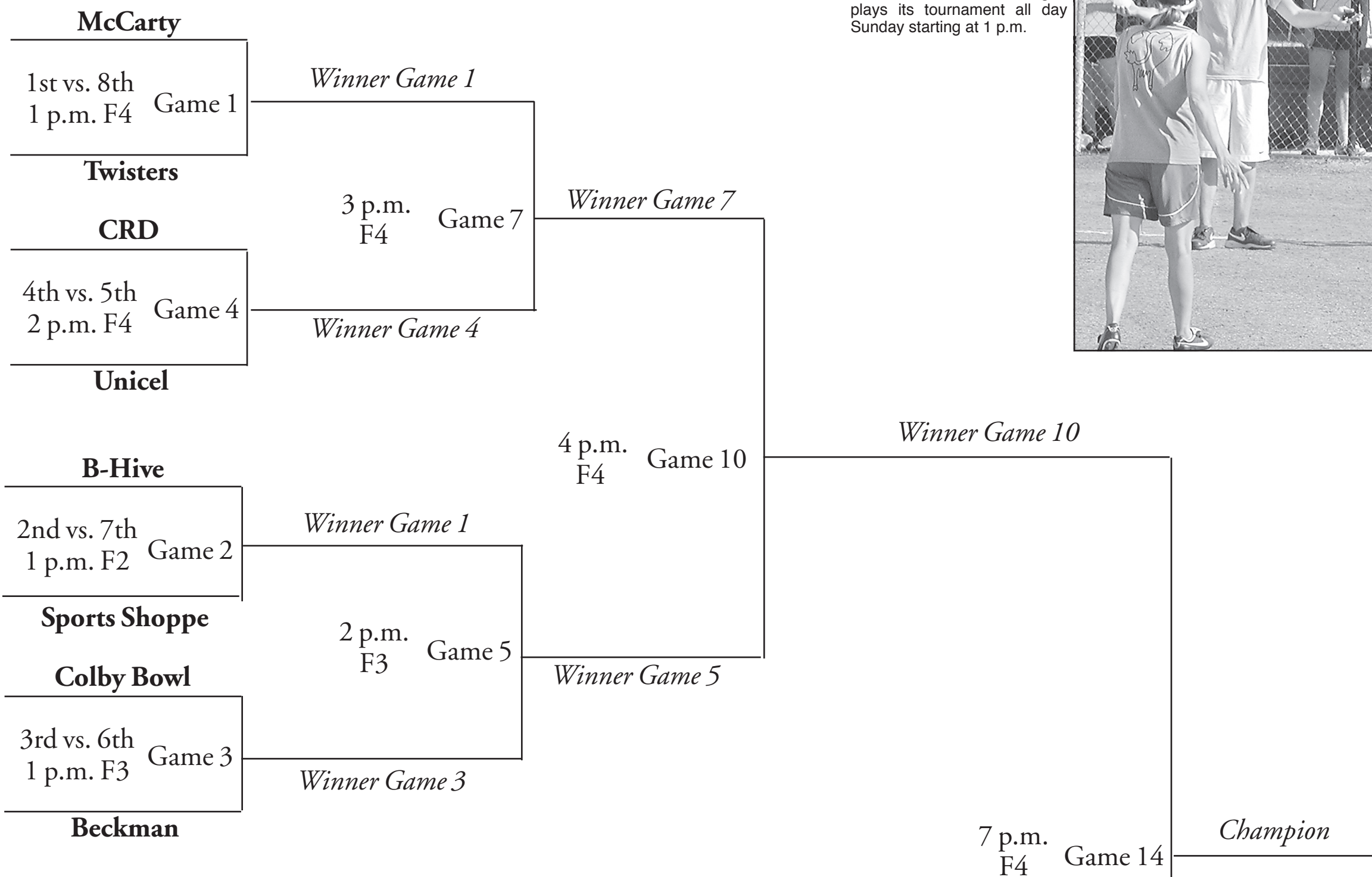

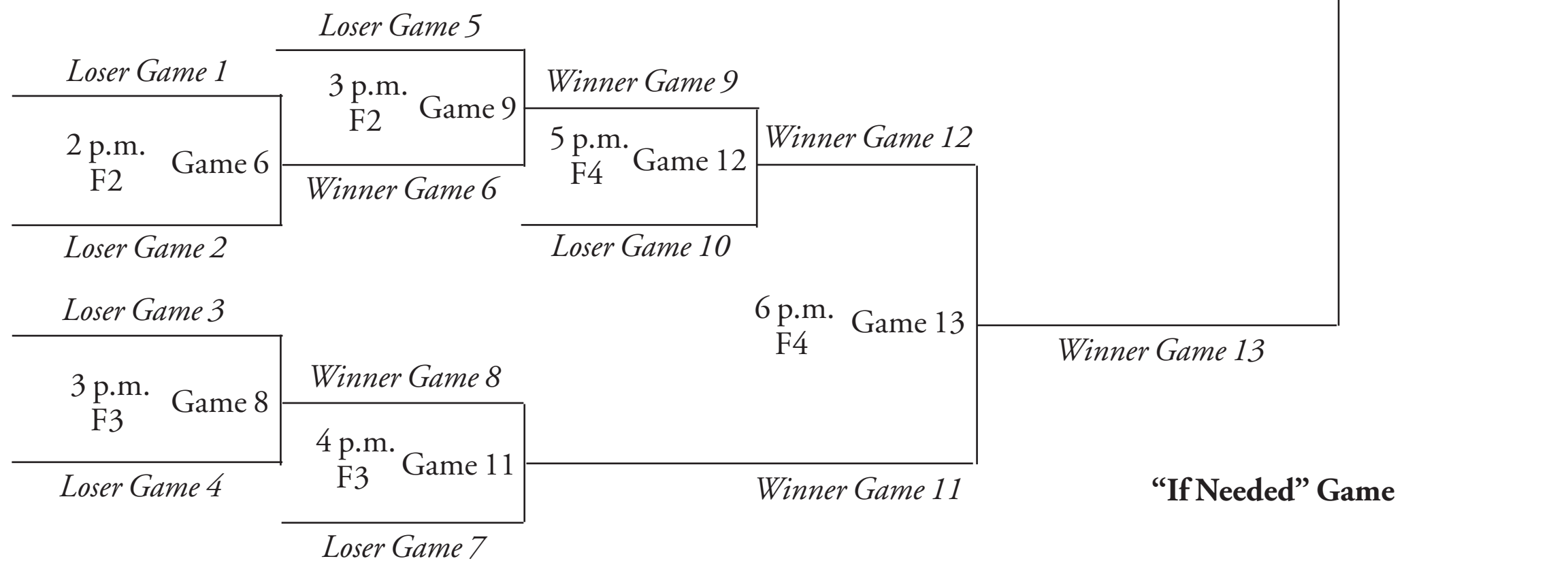

Registration open for Goodland triathlon

The Goodland Activities Center is sponsoring the third annual Goodland Community Triathlon on Saturday, Aug. 13.

This event will be held in conjunction with the Sherman County Class Reunion. There will be competitive and non-competitive divisions. In the non-competitive division, a team of three people can enter the race with each person completing one leg of the race. This

race is meant to be for those people that want a personal challenge to push beyond their physical, mental, and spiritual boundaries.

The swimming will take place at Steever Park Water Park. The swim leg is .5 mile (750-meter). From there a 12.4 mile (20K) bike ride will take you through Goodland and out towards the Sugar Hill Golf Course. Your return trip will take you back through Goodland

to Gulick Park where the run will begin. The run is 3.1 miles (5K), giving you the chance to view the scenic downtown area. The race will conclude back at Steever Park.
