will back up data automatically to a hard drive and will have the ability to burn DVDs straight

"All right, now how much is it going to cost and who has the money?" asked commissioner Paul Steele.

The sheriff's department representatives explained they have been lucky enough to gain access to low-cost equipment and installation using a bid obtained by Kansas Highway Patrol from Mobile Vision in Denver. Equipment, installation, GPS capabilities and extended warranty costs for five patrol vehicles totals \$25,437.50.

County Attorney Kevin Berens explained to commissioners that because the bidding process has already taken place at the state level, a repeat is not required at the local level since the winning bid will be commissioned for Thomas County use.

Berens said he made a commitment to the sheriff's department, that if approved, he would provide up to 50 percent of funding from the Diversion Fund because, as Finley explained, 'when we can provide such high-quality evidence, it makes prosecution so much easier."
