ORDINANCE NO. 1495

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDI-NANCE NO. 1464, SECTION 7, EXCESS POWER GENERATION CREDIT, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 1473 OF THE CITY OF COLBY, KANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COLBY, KANSAS SECTION 1: Ordinance No. 1464 which

establishes electric service rates for the City of Colby, was approved by the City Counci on December 1, 2009. SECTION 2: SECTION 7. EXCESS POWER GENERATION CREDIT of

Ordinance No. 1464 was repealed by

Ordinance No. 1473, dated February 16, SECTION 3: Ordinance No. 1473 of the City of Colby is hereby repealed.

SECTION 4: Ordinance No. 1464. Section

7, Excess Power Generation Credit is hereby amended to read as follows: During a monthly billing period when the

Customer-generator supplies to the City more energy than the City supplies to the Customer-generator (that is, there is net excess kWh that is delivered to the City) the Customer will be billed the appropriate monthly charges (including meter charge, energy charge, demand charge and applicable taxes) and will be credited for the net excess energy on the next monthly bill at 150% of the current month's rate for excess generation credit. Excess generation credit will be calculated by dividing the City's total cost of power purchased, including transmission and all ancillary charges, by the number of kWh purchased in the period. SECTION 5. This Ordinance is intended

to affect and amend only Section 7 of Ordinance No. 1464, which is titled "Excess Power Generation Credit." SECTION 6. This Ordinance shall take

effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law. PASSED AND APPROVED this 16th day
