NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING AND OF ISSUANCE OF HEALTH FACILITIES REVENUE BONDS

Public notice is hereby given that the City Council of the City of Colby, Kansas (the "City"), will conduct a public hearing November 1, 2011 at 7:30 p.m., or as soon thereafter as may be heard at City Hall, 585 N. Franklin Avenue, Colby, Kansas, in regard to the issuance by the City of its Health Facilities Revenue Bonds (Citizens Medical Center, Inc.), in an aggregate principal amount of approximately \$8,000,000 (the "Bonds"). The Bonds are proposed to be issued by the City under authority of K.S.A. 10-116a and K.S.A. 12-1740 et seq., as amended, to provide funds to: (1) refund approximately \$4,065,000 principal amount of the City's Health Facilities Refunding Revenue Bonds (Citizens Medical Center, Inc.), Series 1998 (the "1998 Bonds"), the proceeds of which were used to finance or refinance the constructing and equipping of improvements to the health care facility located at 100 E. College Drive, Colby, Kansas (the "Medical Center") and to acquire the Prairie Senior Living Complex located at 1625 S. Franklin Avenue, Colby, Kansas (the "Senior Living Complex," together with the Medical Center, the "Health Facilities"); and (2) finance and refinance the constructing and equipping of additional improvements to the Medical Center. The City further intends to continue to lease the Health Facilities to Citizens Medical Center, Inc., a Kansas not-for-profit corporation (the "Tenant"). The governing body of the City will not pass an ordinance authorizing the issuance of the Bonds until said public hearing has been concluded.

Notice is further given, in accordance with K.S.A. 12-1744e, that the City intends to issue the Bonds and lease the Health Facilities to the Tenant as set out above.

A copy of this Notice, together with a copy of the inducement resolution of the City to be considered for adoption on November 1, 2011, indicating the intent of the governing body of the City to issue such Bonds are on file in the office of the City Clerk, or will be as soon as completed, and available for public inspection during normal business hours.

All persons having an interest in this matter will be given an opportunity to be heard at the time and place above specified.
