Lady Titans take third in tournament

The Triplains-Brewster girls basketball team got third place after it beat Cheylin 47-43 in the finals of the Sagebrush Basketball Tournament on Saturday in Brewster. Lady Titan Kasey Hoyt scored a team-high 18 points and Brittany Plummer and Shayna Rogge finished with 12 each.

In pool play, the Titans had lost to Greeley County 55-38 on Dec. 6 and beat Stratton 55-37 on Friday.

Greeley County went on to claim first place after beating Rawlins County in a close game with a score of 51-50.

For fifth and sixth places, the St. Francis and Stratton girls played one another, and St. Francis came out on top 52-37 to earn fifth place and put Stratton in sixth.

On the boys side, St. Francis was the champion, beating Stratton 66-59 to claim first place.

To determine third and fourth places, Cheylin played Greeley County and won the game 61-43 to grab third and put Greeley County in fourth.

For fifth and sixth places, Triplains-Brewster faced Rawlins County and the latter came out with the win 49-45, putting Rawlins County in fifth and Triplains-Brewster in sixth place. The Titans' Michael Schmidt scored a team-high 18 points in that game followed by Gus Lamb with 11.

In pool play, the Titans had played Greeley County on Dec. 6

and lost the game 66-36 and lost again on Friday to Stratton with a score of 55-50.

The tournament also included a free throw contest and a three-point shooting contest for both genders.

The boys free throw champion was A.J. Govert of Greeley County and the runner-up was Mason Schiltz of St. Francis. The three-point champion was Dan Brown of Triplains-Brewster and the runner-up was Isaac Schiltz of St. Francis.

The girls free throw champion was Plummer of Triplains-Brewster and the runner-up was Courtney Nemechek of Greeley County. The girls three-point champion was Jenna Hill of St. Francis and the runner-up was Hoyt of Triplains-Brewster.

The boys and girls all-tournament teams were announced after each respective championship game as well.

On the boys' team was Jorge Cruz of Stratton, Kyle May of Stratton, Ethan Young of Cheylin, Cesar Yanez of Greeley County and Isaac Schiltz of St. Francis. On the girls' team was Hillary Chvatal of Rawlins County, Hoyt of Triplains-Brewster, Keley Crittenden of Greeley County, Stephanie Busse of Cheylin and Kaitlin Figgins of St. Francis.

Lastly, the School Sportsmanship Award was given to St. Francis.
