Century of grime off dome

ration. A portion will be retained for the historical record and pictures taken of the rest, he said.  
While the campaign to rehabilitate the dome's interior proceeds, proposals to spend an extra \$21 million to replace copper covering the dome and the House and Senate chambers irritate politicians returning Monday for the 2012 session who wonder when cost escalations

will end.  
The project, started in 2001, was expected to cost taxpayers \$120 million. Additions to the plan and obstacles raised the figure to \$320 million.  
Barry Greis, the Statehouse architect, said the plan had been to repair rather than replace copper roofing. Despite continuous patching during the past 10 years, he said, water continues to seep into the structure.  
Estimated cost of replac-

ing copper on the dome is set at \$10.3 million, while a new copper roof over the legislative chambers may cost \$11.3 million. The state can recoup \$250,000 by salvaging old copper roofing, Greis said.  
The dome's steel ribs are in good shape, Rinner said, but the exterior copper was beyond repair.  
"The copper is in very bad shape," the construction manager said.

Grant to help on plan

Olson said the grant will help pay for consulting and experts to help lay the groundwork to ensure plans are started and completed correctly.  
"The walking trail is just one aspect of this larger and more complex mission of designing a healthier community throughout the entire city of Colby," said Sue Evans, Healthy Communities Design project director.  
"We've asked ourselves how, exactly, do we design our community to promote walking and how do we develop and instill a desire to bike instead of drive? The grant ... will provide these answers and help us develop a plan. It will fund training for our technical assistance team of six, provide salary for staff, help us engage residents, overcome barriers and challenges and access resources."

The plan will help the group implement changes that support physical activity in public places throughout Colby, she said. It will also allow for the development of policies by businesses to promote healthy lifestyles, make sure city ordinances are followed and allow for an assessment of policies, practices and environmental design.  
Evans said that the Kansas Health Foundation has assigned a technical assistant consultant to Colby who will provide expertise and support as projects are developed and implemented. The local team of six has been invited to training in Wichita in a couple of weeks.

"We want Kansans to enjoy the benefits of regular physical activity, such as lowering disease and risk and increasing overall health," said Steve Coen, president and chief financial officer of the statewide foundation. "Through this initiative, we're excited to partner with organizations and communities across Kansas to help develop sustainable plans to better create environments where physical activity is not only possible, but becomes part of a person's routine lifestyle."

In addition to the walking trail and the design initiative, Smart Start Northwest Kansas in Colby has completed a Safe Routes to School project which will complement plans to make Colby "the most walkable community in Kansas." Evans said updates on the project will be delivered at a public event later this month, followed by an information meeting on the walking trail in February.

"Tim Burton's movie was a big hit at the time, so it was naturally a popular idea to revisit the story for the Hill City students," said Robert. "Of course, I didn't want it to be the same, so I aged Alice and made her more relatable for the kids."  
The play was picked up by the Montana publishing firm and added to their online roster of plays Tuesday. Although "Allie

in Wonderland" is Robert's first published work, he said he has written monologues, short stories and other short plays, one of which was produced in Hill City in July 2010. The play, called "The Absolute, Real Story of Tom Sawyer as Told by Becky Thatcher," featured students from Hill City and McPherson College.  
Last month, Robert said, he received third place for his short story, "A Bird in the Hand," at the seventh annual Call for Voices
