# Trojan men fall to Seward at home 74-69

The Colby Community College men's suffered a heartbreaking loss Wednesday at the hands of Seward County Community College at the Community Building. The Trojans lost 74-69 in the final minutes.

The men were neck and neck with Seward until the middle of the second half. They were down by as much as 15, but they fought their way back to within 2 points with 27 seconds left. Marty Wendel had made a basket to put the score at 69-67.

Seward came roaring back however, making 2 free throws and grabbing a steal that led a basket. The Saints had scored 4 quick points to go up 73-67 with 12 seconds left.

The Trojans were forced to foul after losing the ball on their possession and Seward sank one more free throw to seal the game.

Colby (6-4 Jayhawk West, 18-6 overall) made 14 of 16 free throws

for an 87.5 percent completion percentage. The Trojans struggled with fouls, though, committing 25 fouls compared to Seward's 14 on the night. Those fouls increased the Saints' free-throw opportunities and they hit 25 of 32 from the line.

Seward (8-2, 20-4) remains in first place in the conference while the Trojans drop to fourth after the loss.

Carson Konrade had a game-high 24 points for Colby, sinking 7 of 11 from the field, 6 of 7 three-point shots and 4 of 4 free throws. He also had 5 steals, 2 rebounds

and 1 assist.

Jamie Adams followed with 13 points, 6 rebounds, 5 assists and 2 steals and Kristan Rolle scored 13 points as well and pulled down 5 rebounds.

Marty Wendel finished the game with 6 points and 2 rebounds, Vincent Dillard had 5 points, 1 rebound, 1 assist and 1 steal, Chaz Sharp had 5 points and 1 steal and John Clarke made 1 three-point basket.

The Trojans head to Dodge City for a game at 7:30 p.m. on Saturday. Dodge City is 3-7 in the conference and 15-9 overall.
