Farm Bureau offers scholarships in county

• Must be a senior at a Thomas County high school.
• Family must be Thomas County Farm Bureau members through the duration of the scholarship.
• High school grade average of

3.0 or higher. Copy of transcript must accompany application.

• Enrolled as a full-time student each semester during the scholarship period.

• Maintain a college grade average of 2.75.
