Rare atlas added to society's archives

A rare fire insurance atlas from 1893 was recently added to Kansas Memory, the Kansas Historical Society's online archives of documents, books and photos. The atlas maps the blocks, lots, buildings and property ownership of Kansas City (formerly Wyandotte, Kansas City and Armourdale). Argentine and Rosedale. Pages from the atlas may be viewed at kansasmemory.org/item/225076.

A street index and an index to businesses and public services precede the plat maps at the beginning of the atlas. Summaries of the operations and facilities of major industries and businesses are included with some plats. Businesses showcased include packing houses, stockyards, grain elevators, and metal smelters and refiners.

The Kansas Historical Society is a state agency that also operates the Kansas Museum of History, State Archives, the Kansas State Capitol Tour Center and 16 state historic sites across Kansas.
