The Colby Community College baseball team won four of five home games last week, beating McCook Community College in one game and Dodge City Community College in three on the college field.

The Trojans (11-5 Jayhawk West conference, 20-11 overall) defeated McCook 19-5 last Thursday. The

stats for this game were not available this morning. Colby then defeated Dodge City in three games on Saturday and Sunday, 1-0, 8-6 and 8-5, but lost the

In the first game, Mike McLaughlin pitched seven innings where he had 3 strikeouts and allowed just 1 hit, no runs and 2 walks. The Trojans had no errors.

Tyler Hays led the team at the plate with 2 of 3 hits, but Kodie Fewin knocked in the only run of the

In the next game, Devin Chavez, Cole Holt, Dylan Klava and Bert Guzman were on the mound for Colby. Overall, the pitchers had 10 strikeouts and allowed 7 hits, 6 runs and 4 walks in seven innings. The men made 1 error.

The lead hitter for the Trojans was Zach Wilson who hit a triple that brought in 2 runs in the sixth. Colby scored all of its runs in that inning.

David Johnson was the main pitcher for the team in game three. He threw for six innings with 9 strikeouts and allowed 6 hits, 4 runs and 2 walks. The team

Kyle Matusoff relieved him for the last inning and had 1 strikeout and allowed 1 run.

Austin Russell led the bats, hitting 3 of 3 at the plate, coming across home plate twice and bringing

In the last game against Dodge City, the Trojans used Drew Posegate, Guzman, Jacob Nath and Matusoff on the mound. Together, the foursome had 10 strikeouts and allowed 12 hits, 6 runs and 1 walk. There were 5 errors.

The leading hitter for Colby was Hunter Brown. who was 2 for 2 at bat, accounted for 2 runs and had 1 run batted in.

The Trojans will play their next games in Garden City beginning at 1 p.m. Friday and Saturday. Their next home game will be at 3 p.m. Tuesday against Western Nebraska Community College.

### Indians pitcher suspended 5 games for hitting player

Cleveland Indians pitcher Ubaldo Jimenez was suspended for five games and fined by Major League Baseball on Monday for intentionally throwing at Colorado's Troy Tulowitzki during a spring train-

Jimenez will serve his suspension during the first five games of the season unless he asks the players' association to appeal the decision by MLB senior vice president Joe Garagiola Jr.

Indians manager Manny Acta expects an appeal.

"He's starting the second game of the season," Acta said. "It's disappointing, but I'm not sur-
