Brewster students second in chalk contest

The Brewster High Art Class traveled to Fort Hays State University April 18 to participate in the annual High School Art Exhibition.

Art 2 student Amber Barrie took nine pieces, including two spray paintings, a calligraphy drawing, a watercolor, a pencil drawing, a scratch art, a Photoshop photo, a photograph and a pencil vs. camera. She received awards on all nine.

The Art I students each took seven pieces. Dara Roulier and Jessica Johnson received five awards each. Roulier received an award

on two pencil drawings, a paper iris, watercolor and a spray painting. Johnson received awards on three photographs, one Photoshop project and a colored pencil weave drawing.

Layton Werth brought home four awards on a mixed media using acrylic, beading and a deer skull, a pencil drawing, a Photoshop project and a paper iris. Corinna Hanisch and Alicia Barrie each earned three awards. Hanisch's awards included a pencil drawing of herself, a colored pencil/pencil weave drawing and a Photoshop project. Barrie earned awards on her watercolor, a spray painting and a Photoshop project.

Two three-member teams from Brewster

competed in the sidewalk chalk-drawing competition. The drawings had to incorporate at least four of the five listed images: cows, chickens, cactus, crows and Kansas landscape. They were judged on overall composition and creative use of the images. The grand prize winner received a traveling trophy and a Fort Hays T-shirt, while the runner-up received a T-shirt.

There were over 60 teams competing. Corinna, Layton and Alicia took second place, the first time Brewster has placed in the eight years the school has participated.
