## Woman stops suspect with paint ball gun

GALVESTON, Texas (AP) – Police say a southeast Texas woman whipped out a paint ball gun and opened fire with a distinctive yellow hue to stop a burglary suspect.

Galveston police say a 53-year-old man who sometimes mowed the woman's yard was arrested inside her home.

Bond has been set at \$40,000 for Elvis Alexander

of Galveston on a charge of burglary of a habitation with intent to commit theft. Online jail records did not list an attorney for Alexander.
