Cancer charity event planned for local woman

is the one who suggested doing a fund raiser to educate and raise awareness, but we also want raise money to help her, too."

"She is so positive, strong and is very family oriented," said banker Kris Cameron, fellow event coordinator and Zumba instructor. "You always see her around town with grandkids."

Weigel said she hopes the event, the school's first Zumbathon fund raiser, brings in \$10,000, saying it may be a lofty goal, but its enough to make a difference, which is what they are aiming to do.

Carney said she was diagnosed with breast cancer in April 2012 during a routine checkup, thanks to her daughter-in-law, Tricia Carney, a nurse practitioner at the Center for Family Health Care at Citizens Medical Center, who always talks about the importance of getting an exam.

Then, during surgery in May, doctors found cancer in her lymph nodes, too.

"I feel very good now, although it is an aggressive type of cancer," said Carney. "When I was diagnosed, I didn't have any sort of symptoms and no pain at all. I was lucky that it was caught early."

"I am now undergoing chemotherapy and try to keep a positive attitude about everything. I'm losing my hair, but I have to remind myself that that's a good thing because it means the chemo is working."

Weigel said the fire department has supported the cause, especially since Carney has a lot of relatives in the department. Her husband, Ross, is a training officer, and she has two brothers who are volunteer fire fighters, Dwayne Plumisto and Chuck Plumisto, plus two nephews, Bruce Plumisto and Austin Plumisto, also volunteers.

"Some of the firefighters of Colby will be leading a special Zumba routine," said Weigel, "in honor of Cathy and everyone affected by breast cancer. We hope a lot of people stop by at 8 p.m. for that fun routine to 'I'm Sexy and I Know It' by LMFAO."

She said people will get the opportunity to try out the Latin-inspired Zumba aerobics, too. She, Cameron and Sara Betz will instruct and lead people in the dance.

"It's visually inspired and uses hand signals to change movements," said Cameron. "This way everyone can follow along, even people who don't speak English."

"And it's so much fun and easy enough to do," added Weigel, "so anyone can give it a try."

She said a special "Zumbatomic" lesson for kids 3 and up will be given around 7:15 p.m. It's a high-energy fitness routine that kids have a lot of fun dancing to, she said.

In addition to Zumba and Zumbatomic, there'll be tours of the fire station, a watermelon feed and free snow cones, limbo and bean-bag toss for kids. Prizes will be raffled off and free massages given.

"We'll also have a pink fire truck from Wichita ... to raise awareness and support," said Weigel, "and health-care people from the hospital will talk about breast cancer and answer questions."

"The event will be so much fun, and I hope everyone will come," said Carney. "I've received so much support from people in Colby. There are lots of wonderful people in this town and it is amazing to know that so many care."

"I'll be there. Breast cancer has touched so many lives, even in Colby, and I hope people will come to help show support."

Thousands may be knocked off Internet due to malware

WASHINGTON – Despite repeated alerts, tens of thousands of Americans may still lose their Internet service Monday unless they do a quick check of their computers for malware that could have taken over their machines more than a year ago.

The warnings about the Internet problem have been splashed across Facebook and Google. Internet service providers have sent notices, and the FBI set up a special website.

According to the FBI, the number of computers that probably are infected is more than 277,000 worldwide, down from about 360,000 in April. Of those still infected, the FBI believes that about 64,000 are in the United States.

People whose computers are still infected Monday will lose their ability to go online, and they will have to call their service providers for help deleting the malware and reconnecting to the Internet.

The problem began when international hackers ran an online advertising scam to take control of more than 570,000 infected computers around the world. When the FBI went in to take down the hackers late last year, agents realized that if they turned off the malicious servers being used to control the computers, all the victims would lose their Internet service.

In a highly unusual move, the FBI set up a safety net. They brought in a private company to install two clean Internet servers to take over for the malicious servers so that people would not suddenly lose their Internet.

Kansas will not pay rest of contract

TOPEKA (AP) – State revenue officials say Kansas will not pay the final 10 percent of its contract for a new \$40 million motor vehicle system until problems are fixed.

The Kansas Department of Revenue notified the 3M Co. last Thursday that it needs to im-

prove the new software, which has caused long lines and frustration at motor vehicle offices across the state since it was installed seven weeks ago.

Donna Shelite, the state director of vehicles, told the Shawnee County Commission that as many as 73,000 records didn't

convert correctly to the new system.

The Topeka Capital-Journal reports (bit.ly/OlbJlJ) Shelite told the commission that Kansas officials have asked 3M to address the system's response times, availability, bugs and maintenance.
