not yet been found. Washburn and Vacik said they would like to find a facility that could also accommodate adult education classes.

Chairman Arlen Leiker asked about the EduKan assessment, and Vacik said the quality of EduKan classes is excellent and the return on investment has been high. EduKan presidents

were to meet Wednesday in Topeka.

- Heard a report from Barry Kaaz, dean of external affairs, who recommended using sealed bids to dispose of the unwanted college vehicles since the trade-in values given by local dealers were low. He asked to defer more comments until later in the agenda.

Leiker commended Kaaz on the alternative energy graphs he

had produced. Kaaz said he is optimistic that with the 12 sub-meters installed this summer, electric demand usage will go down also.

- Heard from Ryan Sturdy, athletic director, who said the women’s golf team did well at the two-day local tournament the college held. Two Colby women tied for second place. Leiker said he knew of incidents where some coaches were buy-

ing meals for board members and he wanted this practice to be stopped. Sturdy agreed to take care of it.

- Heard from Wells that the annual meeting of the Endowment Foundation will be Tuesday, Oct. 2. He invited all trustees to attend. He reported that weeds had been destroyed on the college farm land south of the campus and grass has been planted.

fore they enter the park alone, Lavitt said, and part of the plan would be to have signs around the park warning users that they assume liability if their dog fights with someone else’s pet.

“It’s better for the animals to learn to like other dogs instead of just being with one

owner,” she added.

Friends of the Colby Dog Park is also the name of a fund set up under the Thomas County Community Foundation. Lavitt said donations, which should be tax-deductible, could be sent to the foundation under that name.

She said that their goal is to raise \$75,000, but that since a five-foot chain link fence

around the park would be the most expensive part of setting it up, it would be hard to know the cost before the land is acquired.

The group will probably add up expenses and bring the issue up again sometime this winter, Lavitt said. Interim City Manager Randy Jones said that they will have to ask to have the park on the city’s agenda when they’re ready.

Apple supplier halts factory after brawl

The violence did not appear to be work-related, the company and police said. Comments posted on Chinese Internet bulletin boards said it might have erupted after a security guard hit

an employee.

Photos posted on microblog service Sina Weibo showed broken windows, a burned vehicle and police with riot helmets, shields and clubs.

Phone calls to police headquarters and the Taiyuan city

hall were not answered. People reached by phone at restaurants and other businesses in the area said they had no details about the clash.

In the past year, Foxconn has faced scrutiny over workers’ complaints about wages and

working hours.

The company raised minimum pay and promised in March to limit hours after an auditor hired by Apple found Foxconn employees were regularly required to work more than 60 hours a week.

Candidates fight for working-class voters in ads

CHICAGO – The presidential candidates are criticizing each other in new television commercials aimed at winning working-class voters who could help swing the election, pitting Republican Mitt Romney’s wealth against the loss of American jobs to China on President Barack Obama’s watch.

As Romney dispatched running mate Paul Ryan to kick off a three-day bus tour in the critical battleground of Ohio, Obama began running an ad in the state trying to use his GOP rival’s own words against him.

It’s the campaign’s first spot using Romney’s comments that 47 percent of voters pay no income tax, and believe they are victims and entitled to government assistance. The 30-second ad also points out that Romney paid just 14.1 percent in federal taxes last year on \$13.7 million in income and refuses to release his returns before 2010.

“Maybe instead of attacking others on taxes, he should come clean on his,” the ad says.

Romney is trying to shift the debate off his personal wealth and private comments to donors to worker resentment over jobs moving to China. His new ad released today is his latest salvo in a string of criticism against Obama’s handling of the rising Asian power.

The commercial showed a photo of a shuttered factory and says fewer Americans are working as China steals the country’s ideas and technology. “Obama had years to stand up to China. We can’t afford four more,” the spot concludes.

Six weeks out from the election, Obama holds a slim lead over Romney in most battleground states. The Republican is seeking to right his campaign following a rough stretch that included the release of his secretly recorded remarks about the 47 percent and criticism that he’s not campaigning hard enough for the White House.

Romney acknowledged Sunday that he was trailing the president in several key states. But he promised to spend less time courting donors and more time with voters.

“I know that in the coming six weeks they’re very unlikely to stay where they are today,” Romney said of the polls.

The Republican was scheduled to campaign today in Colorado, where aides added a rally in an attempt to deflect the criticism from within his own party. Romney was to join Ryan in Ohio on Tuesday for the final two days of bus tour.

Obama will spend today and Tuesday tending to official duties at the United Nations.

But his condensed schedule at the annual gathering of world leaders underscored that his focus is largely on the campaign.

Voters in more than two dozen states are already casting ballots in early voting for the presidential election, meaning everything the candidates do now could influence votes already being cast.

Kansas students scored higher on SAT exam

TOPEKA (AP) – Kansas students are outpacing the national average on the SAT college-entrance exam.

The state’s Department of Education said today that scores

increased in all content areas in 2012. The biggest increase was in reading, where students scored 595 out of 800.

About 5 percent of the state’s graduates took the exam – a low

number that contributes to Kansas’ higher-than-average scores.

The reason few Kansas students take the test is because the ACT historically is more popular in the central states, with the

SAT more popular on the East and West coasts. The Kansas students taking the SAT tend to be more prepared, with many of them considering admission to out-of-state schools.
