Man goes through the roof trying to steal beer

ALTOONA, Pa. (AP) - A man has been jailed on charges he climbed through a roof vent in a failed attempt to steal two 30-packs of cheap beer from a central Pennsylvania store.

Online court records don't list an attorney for 20-year-old Derek Dasher, of Tyrone, who faced a preliminary hearing on burglary and other charges.

The Altoona Mirror (bit.ly/10umj1a) reports Dasher climbed down into the cooler at

Cassidy's Brew Zoo through the vent on a Wednesday afternoon while the store was still open for business.

Police say he took two packs of Keystone Light worth \$36.99 and ran out the back door, but was caught by an employee.

Police say Dasher was in the store's office when they arrived and acknowledged stealing the beer.
