

Freeze grease until trash day

Dear Heloise: After cooking greasy foods such as bacon, the grease is poured into a metal can (example: coffee) and placed in the freezer with the original lid.

WHITE PEPPER

Dear Heloise: What is the difference between white pepper and black pepper? Why use one instead of the other? - Linda W. in Indiana Black pepper is harvested when the pepper-

corns are still green or black. It has a stronger smell and more distinct flavor than white pepper. White pepper comes from fully matured ber-

ries that are yellow or red. Once the skin falls off, the white pulp is dried and processed to make white pepper. White pepper can be used in white or light-colored creams and sauces because of its delicate, mild flavor. It also doesn't show up as big, black flakes in a light-colored dish. There is a big difference in cost between the

Actually, there is! Try substituting the same amount of honey, molasses or maple syrup. Howfect the overall flavor. - Heloise



Think Before You Leap

When dummy is short of entries, it is usually just as apparent to the defenders as it is to the declarer. In such cases, the defenders should try to shape their play so as to take advantage of declarer's limited access to dummy. Consider this deal where faulty defense allowed declarer to make a contract that should have been defeated. West led a club, and South won East's ten with

the king. The obvious suit to attack was hearts, so declarer led a heart to the jack. East won with the queen and returned a club. South took the trick with the queen, forced out the ace of hearts and finished with 10 tricks consisting of two spades, three hearts, two diamonds and three clubs. East could have prevented South from mak-

ing even nine tricks. When the heart was led at trick two, he should have allowed dummy's jack to win. Declarer would most likely take a spade finesse at this point. West wins with the king and returns


a club. Regardless of how South continues, he falls one trick short of his contract, scoring only one heart trick instead of three and eight tricks instead of 10. East should reason that dummy's hearts are likely to be dead if he refuses to win the first heart trick. He can see that if South has only two

hearts, he will not be able to establish the suit and then bring it home. West's play of the deuce on the first heart lead, indicating three cards in the suit, should cause East to adjust his defense accordingly. Usually, the holdup play in notrump is reserved for declarer, but there are many times – and this

is one of them - where the defenders can adopt a
