Weather to blame for slow planting

Spring rain and some snow have delayed corn planting in Kansas, a bittersweet problem to have, said Kansas Corn Commission Chair Mike Brzon.

He said farmers need good soil moisture and also warm soil temperatures to get their crop off to a good start.

"The soil needs the moisture but that and the cold weather is pushing our planting progress back on the calendar," Brzon said. "But forecasts show improving conditions for planting and we can plant a lot of corn in a short time."

As of April 22, 5 percent of the state's corn crop has been

planted. The five-year average for that week regarding Kansas corn planting is 20 percent and last year the state's corn growers were ahead with 30 percent planted.

Last year's corn planting in Kansas, however, was extremely early. In 2012, 75 percent of the Kansas corn crop was in the ground by the first week of May. The five year average for the first of May for Kansas corn planting is around 50 percent.

A cool, wet spring has delayed planting across much of the country, according to reports from the U.S. Department of Agriculture.
