

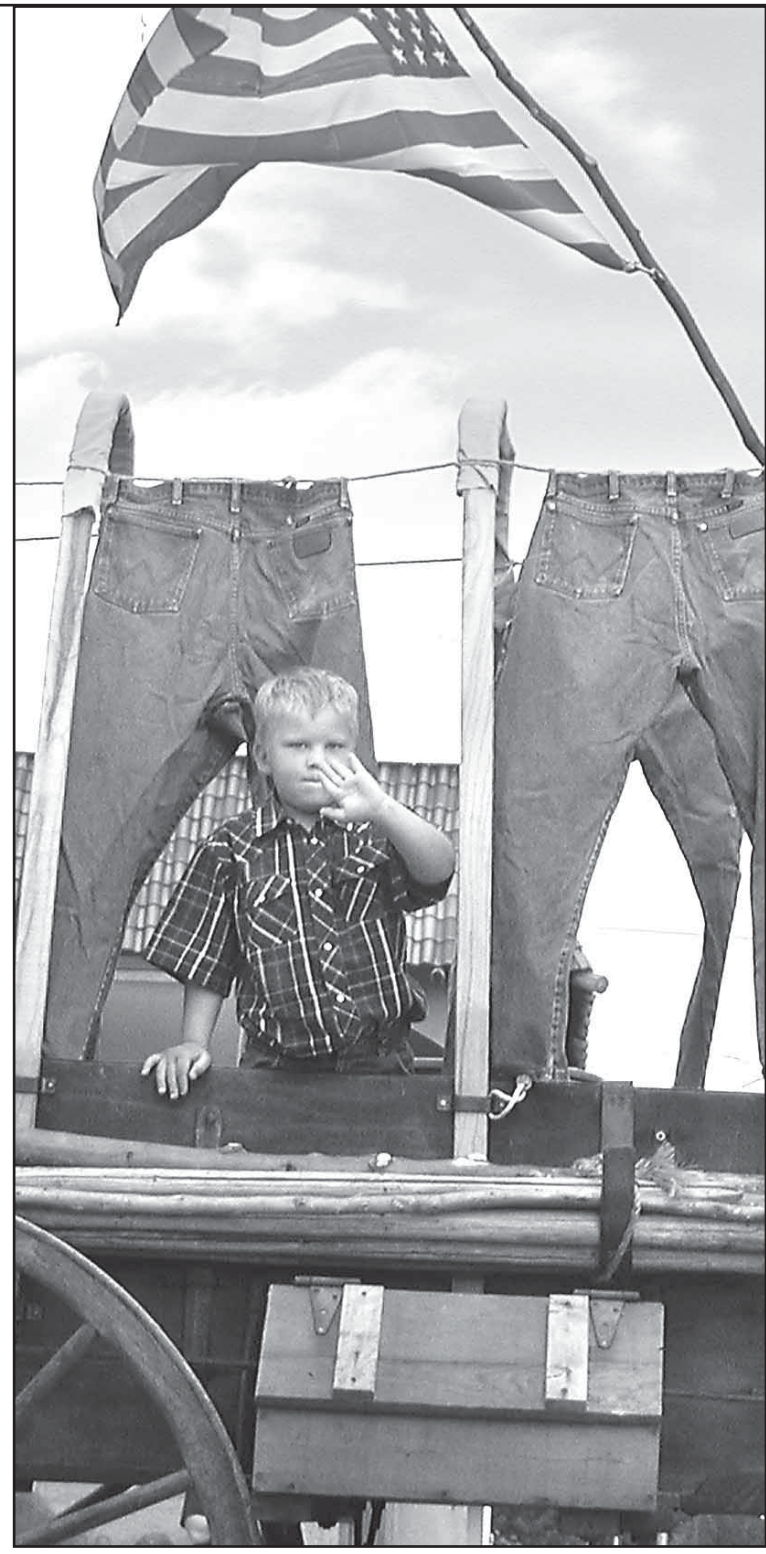
Parade time brings smiles

Again, all claims shall comply with the strict requirements for claims set forth in K.S.A. 60-4111.
