

A Condensed Explanation

Dear Heloise: Would you please address the difference between CONDENSED AND EVAP-ORATED MILK? -- Christine F., Lignum, Va.

Happy to, as it can be a little confusing. Sweetened condensed milk is WHOLE MILK that is heated until about 60 percent of the water is removed and sugar is added. It is used when making candies and desserts.

Evaporated milk is whole milk that is heated until 50 percent of the water is removed, but NO sugar is added. It is used in custards, sauces and puddings to make them thick and smooth. You CANNOT substitute condensed milk for evaporated milk or vice versa. However, I do have a Heloise's Seasonings, Sauces and Substitutes pamphlet that shares a lot of food ideas you CAN substitute for one another. #### **SWEET SPICE**

Dear Readers: Looking for a new spice to add to your cooking? Try mace. No, not the stuff used to spray bad guys. With a sweet flavor, it is more pungent than nutmeg, with a golden-brown color. Mace is part of the nutmeg seed. You can buy it ground or whole-blade. Since the two are closely related, you can substitute nutmeg and mace in Mace can be added to desserts, barbecue sauce

and Swedish meatballs. It even can be sprinkled on potatoes or added to vegetable soups. Pick up a small bottle and spice up your life a little! --VEGETABLE BROTH

#### Dear Heloise: Don't toss those vegetable peel-

ings, woody stems, not-so-perfect-for-salad tomatoes, etc. Save them in a zipper-top bag in the freezer with stems from parsley or other herbs. When I have a bagful, I plunk it all into a pot, add water and one 12-ounce can of vegetable juice, and make some vegetable broth. I let this simmer until the "vegetables" are

done. Strain the broth and toss the veggies. You get a real nice broth for soup or whatever you make that calls for broth. You also can refreeze of garlic and a bay leaf makes a great soup starter or simply a warm broth on a cool day. -- Susan, via email TRASH BAGS



# **Plain Horse Sense**

There are hands where you'd swear declarer must have peeked at the defenders' cards to have played as well as he did. But in most such cases, declarer's plays are found to be based on nothing more than plain common sense.

Consider this deal where South played in a way that might seem abnormal, but made the contract as a result. He took East's jack of diamonds with the king, led a club to the queen – on which West produced the ten – and returned a club toward his hand. When East followed with the six, declarer finessed the eight and, after it held, quickly collected 10 tricks. Had South played the clubs less efficiently -

that is, had he simply cashed two high clubs – the expectation of a normal 3-2 division in the suit – he would have scored at most eight tricks. Declarer had good reason to play the clubs as

he did. He recognized that he needed only four club tricks to make the contract. This meant he could afford to lose a club trick to West - who could do him no harm if the finesse lost - in order to guard against East's holding four clubs. South did not really expect the eight of clubs

to win the trick – the odds were distinctly against that – but he realized that, win or lose, the deep finesse assured the contract.


