


# Heloise Hints from Heloise Chinese beets a family recipe

Dear Heloise: I lost your recipe for Heloise's Chinese beets. I looked for it, but it doesn't seem to be anywhere. - Joan R., via e-mail

It's been years since this family recipe was printed. It's a good time to run it again. Get together the following:

- 6 cups, or 3 (16 ounces each) cans, sliced or whole beets
- 1 cup sugar
- 1 cup vinegar
- 2 tablespoons cornstarch strong taste)
- 3 tablespoons ketchup
- 3 tablespoons oil (optional)
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- Salt to taste

Drain the beets. Set aside 1 1/2 cups of the liquid. In a medium saucepan, place the beets and reserved liquid. Then add all the remaining ingredients. Mix well and cook for 3 minutes over medium heat, or until the mixture thickens. Let cool before storing in the refrigerator. Serve as a side dish or in a salad. # MAKING MOLASSES


Dear Heloise: Is blackstrap molasses the same as regular molasses? - Louise S., via e-mail

No, it is not! Molasses comes from the juice of sugar cane or sugar beets. The juice is boiled to remove the sugar crystals. How many times the juices are boiled determines the type of molasses.

Light or regular molasses is made from the first boiling, while dark molasses comes after a second boiling. Blackstrap molasses is what remains used in slow-cooking recipes, e.g., baked beans or barbecue. - Heloise

#### SEEDING SQUASH

Dear Heloise: Cleaning out the pulp and seeds when preparing winter squash using a spoon was difficult. I looked in my utensil drawer and chose the larger end of my melon-ball cutter. The insides of the squash come out with very little effort using the melon-ball cutter. Don't turn it; simply pull it along the inside of the squash. The pulp and seeds come out easily. - W.B. in Texas



#### **Cutting the Gordian Knot**

In bridge, as in war, interfering with enemy communications can sometimes produce a victory that could not otherwise be attained. In today's deal, which occurred in a national championship, declarer made good use of a communicationsbreaking play to salvage his contract.

South was Richard Freeman, "Quiz Kids" star of radio two generations ago. West led the king of clubs, and Freeman won with the ace. It was apparent that the only real threat to the contract was the possibility of a club ruff, but instead of leading a trump at trick two to try to eliminate this threat, Freeman led the jack of diamonds!

As a result of this play, the contract could no longer be defeated. The only tricks declarer eventually lost were a heart, a diamond and a club.

Now let's suppose that South had led a trump at trick two, as most declarers in Freeman's shoes probably would have done. In that case, the contract would have gone down one with proper defense.

West would have taken the ace of trumps, cashed the queen of clubs, led a low diamond to East and ruffed East's club return to score the fourth trick for the defense. Furthermore, this series of plays by East-West would not have been hard to find.

West would naturally assume that East, for his four-diamond bid, was likely to have the king of that suit, and East would assume that West's underlead of the ace of diamonds after cashing the queen of clubs at trick three was a clear-cut request for a club return.

The jack-of-diamonds lead at trick two cut a vital link in East-West's line of communications, and in one fell swoop short-circuited the defense.
