truck, Public Works Director Omar Weber said, "which is \$36,000 more than I expected."

McGreer said later the city can expect to get the truck in five or six months.

• Approved a request from Walmart to store shipping containers onsite for 90 days during the holiday season. The city tabled the request at its last meeting and the store has since gathered more information, such as where the containers will be stored.

• Approved an ordinance to incorporate the zoning regulations for the city and the airport into a single document. McGreer said this basically puts

all of the amendments added to the regulations since 1997, including 17 the Municipal Height Hazard regulations the city adopted earlier this year, into a single document.

• Discussed the lower revenues at the Aquatic Park. McGreer said the park might simply be declining in popularity after its first years of operation, and that the city is now paying for lifeguard training.

"There are very few pools in the world that limit themselves, but my job is to limit the damage," he said, referring to the profits from the pool.

Mayor Gary Adrian said he often drives by the park and sees many out-of-town license plates.

Roofer adds new certification

A roofing company in town has a new kind of certification from the International Code Council to help in its work as of Friday, after an employee passed a difficult test with little preparation.

Kelly Simmonds, the office manager for Murray Roofing, earned an International Building Code certification for Class B residential and commercial roofing. Simmonds earned the certification because his company needed it for a job in Salina and others in the near future. He studied for just three days for a test that some take months or years to prepare for.

He is the first one in the company to earn the certification. "He can put a roof on pretty much any building (up to four stories high) in the U.S. with that," said company owner Jim Murray.

Two books sit on Simmond's desk that he used to take the test, offered by the international council. The largest is 705 pages and the second is about 150 pages, dealing with the kind of

plumbing used for drainage on roofs and throughout the building. He said he got them last Tuesday afternoon and studied last week with the help of "lots and lots of hours and lots of caffeine," until he took the test Friday.

"I would work half the day here and then go home and study until 8 or 9 o'clock," he said.

Murray had to get him to leave the office some nights, Simmonds said, but he passed with a 95 percent score and earned his certification.

Later, a woman who was working at the testing facility told Simmonds it was a very difficult test.

"She said there are people that go to Fort Hays State University and they study for two or three years to take the test," he said, "and (some people) tried five times and they still haven't passed."

The company was working on the roof of Mr. Penguin Tuxedo Sales and Rental in Salina, when Murray said he learned the city required a license that could only be obtained by someone with the certification.

"I had been told that it would

take two or three months to study for this test," he said.

When Simmonds, who has worked at the company for five years, volunteered to try, Murray was not optimistic about his chances, but he told his office manager to go ahead and try when he insisted on making the attempt.

Simmonds credited his success in part to studying trigonometry and calculus – both on the test – in high school. While he was going to Colby Community College, he helped tutor others in both subjects.

He also taught himself Auto Cad, architectural engineering and how to read spec books and blueprints while he was deployed to Djibouti with the Kansas National Guard for just over a year. Another big factor to his passing the test, Simmonds said, is knowledge he acquired over the years working for the company.

Simmonds pointed out that there were several rules and regulations that could be used in the near future that were covered in the book. And some companies he has encountered do not follow them.

"So we're already ahead of the game when we require it," he said.

Teen may be charged as adult in arson case

HUTCHINSON (AP) – The Reno County District Attorney is seeking to try as an adult a Hutchinson teenager accused of setting a fire that killed his mother and sister.

The Hutchinson News reports (bit.ly/GB7ZOM) Reno County District Attorney Keith Schroeder on Tuesday filed a motion

to try the teen as an adult because the boy is an "extreme danger" to the community and shows no remorse.

The Sept. 26 fire at the family's home killed the 14-year-old boy's mother and sister and injured his father.

Schroeder also says in the motion that the

teen's father is afraid of him, and that the teen had plans for future violence.

As a juvenile, he would be under the court's jurisdiction until he turns 23. If convicted as an adult, he'd face a life prison sentence.
