# Kansans of all ages should get flu vaccine

With flu activity increasing and family and friends gathering for the holidays, the Kansas Department of Health and Environment urges all Kansans to receive an annual flu vaccination to protect themselves and their loved ones.

National Influenza Vaccination Week this week serves as a reminder that all of us have a responsibility to prevent the spread of influenza. Kansas has identified two different types of influenza viruses currently circulating, and, based on data from the Outpatient Influenza-like Illness Surveillance Network, flu activity is currently low within the state. However, flu activity usually increases at this time of year, peaks in January or February, and can last as late as

On average, five to 20 percent home when you are sick. of the U.S. population contracts the flu yearly, and more than 200,000 people are hospitalized with flu complications. Influenza or pneumonia contributed to or was the direct cause of 1,444 deaths among Kansas residents during the 2012-2013 influenza season. Influenza and pneumonia was the eighth leading cause of death in 2012 in Kansas.

"Flu season is here and before it becomes widespread, take the opportunity to get your vaccine now," said Robert Moser, state health officer. "Getting a flu vaccination is also a great way to protect those who are at high risk."

Avoid spreading the flu virus

Nearly all persons six months and older are recommended to receive a flu vaccine every year. Vaccination is especially important for protecting those at high risk for serious flu complications, including young children, pregnant women, adults 65 years and older, and anyone with chronic health conditions like asthma, heart disease and diabetes. Those get your flu vaccine, contact your in contact with an infant less than 6 months old should also be im-

too young to be vaccinated and are more vulnerable to complications.

Symptoms of the flu include: fever, headache, extreme tiredness, dry cough and muscle aches. Complications can include pneumonia, ear and sinus infections and dehydration; the flu might also worsen other chronic condi-
