Cowgirls lose to Ottawa in finals of Topside Tip-Off

The Goodland Star-News The Goodland Cowgirls held a 10-9 lead at the end of the first period in Saturday's title game at the 16th annual Topside Tip-Off basketball tournament, but the Lady Cyclones of Ottawa dominated the rest of the game.

The Ottawa girls took off early in the second period and hung on to win 56-46.

After a slow start by both teams, with no scoring in the first minute, Goodland went on a six-point run for a 8-4 lead. then Ottawa closed up to 10-9 by the end of the first period.

Sophomore Dani Bedore scored the first basket of the second period to increase the Cowgirls lead to 12-9, then the momentum changed abruptly and permanently. A threepoint basket by Ottawa's Mallory Geist tied the score, then teammate Megan Ramsey hit two straight three-pointers to build a 18-12 Cyclone lead.

Ottawa increased its lead to 24-12 before Goodland could score again, and the Cowgirls trailed 26-18 at halftime.

Sophomore Whitney Archer hit a three-pointer to start the third period, but the Cyclones scored the next nine points for a 35-21 lead.

Starting the fourth period behind

42-32, the Cowgirls fought back to within four at 45-41 with about four minutes left in the game, but foul trouble started to take its toll. Archer fouled out with 3 1/2 minutes left, then with the Cowgirls trailing 52-42 and just under a minute left, Bedore fouled out.

Both teams scored four points after that, making the final 56-46 and earning the Lady Cyclones their finals. The Lady Cyclones were the second tournament title in four runners-up in 2002 and 2003.

Against Ottawa, Bedore scored 14 points to lead Goodland, followed by junior Justeen Koehler with 11 and Archer with 10. Sophomore Lindsay Schields added four points, junior Jordan Frazier three and sophomores Emily Murray and Kaylee Billinger each had two.

Bedore and Koehler both had six rebounds to lead the team.

Ottawa senior Kelsie Studley led all scorers with 22 points and Ottawa senior Gaitlin Smith had a game-high 12 rebounds.

The Lady Bluejays of Norton placed third, beating the McCook Lady Bison 56-28 Saturday. Holyoke defeated Wray 51-36 for fifth place and Burlington beat Weskan 68-44 for seventh.

On Thursday, the first day of the tournament, the Cowgirls dominated the Lady Coyotes of Weskan 75-17 for Goodland's third win of the season. Bedore scored 18 points and Archer 17.


