Q.V. Halley

Q.V. Halley, 81, Greeley, Colo., a former St. Francis resident, died Friday, June 30, 2000, at North Colorado Medical Center in Greeley after a lengthy illness.

He was born Nov. 8, 1918, at St. Francis, the son of Jessie (Jacobs) and Lorenzo Halley.

He grew up on a farm and was educated at St. Francis.

During World War II, he served in the U.S. Army from 1942 to 1945.

He and Carolyn Skinner were married in 1946 at Elko, Nev.

After her death, he married Wilma Hall in 1952 at Raton, N.M. She also died.

Then he married Jeanette Moser in 1985 at Las Vegas, Nev.

He worked for AT&T until his retirement in 1981.

During his early years with the telephone company, he moved frequently. He eventually settled in Sterling,

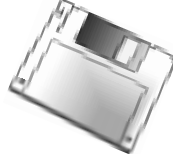
