**ORDINANCE NO. 1436 AN ORDINANCE ATTESTING TO AN INCREASE IN TAX REVENUES FOR BUDGET YEAR 2001 FOR THE CITY OF GOODLAND.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Goodland must continue to provide services to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of this community; and **WHEREAS**, the cost of providing essential services to the citizens of this City continues to increase; and **WHEREAS**, the Kansas Legislature has cut growth in demand transfers to local governments below what is required by state statute; and **WHEREAS**, the 2000 Kansas Legislature significantly reduced demand and transfer payments to local governments below last year's levels;

**NOW THEREFORE**, be it ordained by the Governing Body of the City of Goodland:

**Section One.** In accordance with state law, the City of Goodland has conducted a public hearing and has published the proposed budget necessary to fund city services from January 1, 2001 until December 31, 2001.

**Section Two.** After careful public deliberations, the governing body has determined that in order to maintain the public services, which are essential for the citizens of this city, it will be necessary to budget property tax revenues in an amount, which exceeds the 2000 budget.

**Section Three.** This ordinance shall take effect after publication once in the official city newspaper.

**PASSED and APPROVED** by the Governing Body on this 7th day of August, 2000.

**AMENDING AND REPEALING SECTION 16-101 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF GOODLAND.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GOODLAND, KANSAS:**

**Section 1. INCORPORATING STANDARD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE.** There is hereby incorporated by reference for the purpose of regulating traffic within the corporate limits of the City of Goodland, Kansas, that certain standard traffic ordinance known as the "Standard Traffic Ordinance for Kansas Cities," Edition of 2000, prepared and published in book form by the League of Kansas Municipalities, Topeka, Kansas. No fewer than three copies of said Standard Traffic Ordinance shall be marked or stamped "Official Copy as Adopted by Ordinance No. 1437," and to which shall be attached a copy of this ordinance, and filed with the city clerk to be open to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours. The police department, municipal judge and all administrative departments of the city charged with enforcement of the ordinance shall be supplied, at the cost of the city, such number of official copies of such Standard Traffic Ordinance similarly marked, as may be deemed expedient.

**Section 2. REPEAL.** Section 16-101 of the Code of the City of Goodland, is hereby amended and repealed.

**Section 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official city newspaper.

**PASSED AND APPROVED** this 7th day of August, 2000, by the Governing Body of the City of Goodland, Kansas.
